



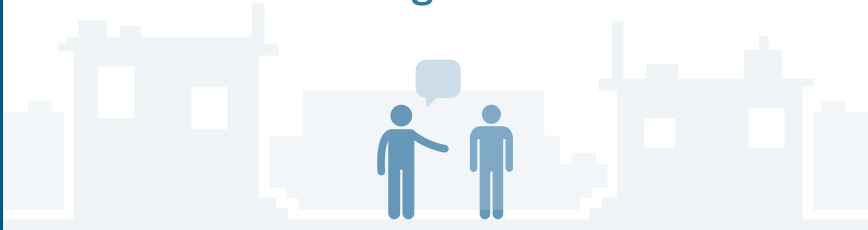
In increasingly **diverse** and **distrustful** societies

MIGRANTS CAN ENHANCE intercultural interaction and community bonds



Migrants can **introduce new information** that **POLICYMAKERS** were not aware of to support programmes

For example, working with **displaced communities** when upgrading informal settlements in **Medellín** enabled **safer living conditions**



Despite this, **MIGRATION REMAINS FAR FROM SAFE AND INCLUSIVE**

The intersectionality of factors leaves some individuals **more vulnerable**

Migrants **have no right to vote** in at least **31** countries out of **56** studied



More than **156,000** victims of **human trafficking** since 2012



60,000 migrants have been reported **dead or missing**

along migratory routes in the last nine years



43% of Venezuelan migrants felt **discriminated** against due to their nationality
